

Eligibility Criteria

Where 'activity' is referred to', this is defined as the project and/or the education opportunity provided by an organisation.

To be eligible to apply to have your organisation's activity displayed and promoted as part of 'Nature Opportunities for Businesses', the below criteria must be met.

Essential Criteria

- The organisation leading the activity must be a registered and not for profit charity
- The primary aim of the organisation leading the activity should relate to the conservation and/or enhancement of the natural environment
- The organisation leading the activity must be based in Guernsey and/or Herm
- The activity must take place in Guernsey and/or Herm
- The activity must relate to the natural environment
- The activity must meet the overall goals and at least one objective of the <u>States of Guernsey</u> <u>Strategy for Nature</u>
- The activity must help address one or more of the drivers of change stated in <u>State of Nature</u> 2024
- An application form must be completed and submitted to office@naturecommission.gg

Desirable Criteria

• The organisation leading the activity should have financial statements either available on their webpage or uploaded to Guernsey Registry. The purpose of this is to evidence the low-risk nature of any partnership with the organisation, as recommended by the Guernsey Financial Services Commission (GFSC) Handbook on Countering Financial Crime¹

Please note that work stipulated under a planning obligation or legal requirement and/ or work within a domestic curtilage are not eligible.

An application can be made at any stage of the activity, such as projects which have commenced and require further funding to continue, as well as projects which are yet to be established.
